## 2021-22 DANCE COMPANY INFORMATION

Our Dance Company is divided into Divisions to offer dancers, ages 6-18, a variety of experiences and performance opportunities. Participation in multiple divisions is encouraged. We're proud to be an organization that cares and gives back through dance. Our Senior Jazz, Tap, Contemporary Divisions offer expanded service opportunities for dancers. New for this season we are thrilled to be including The Movement, a 2-day retreat/ intensive at LoMastro that focuses on the true gifts of self-confidence, vulnerability, acceptance and hard work in a safe and judgement free space. We're excited to return to live-performances, competition, an optional Disney World performance trip and optional film projects.

Audition / Placement: Complete the Commitment Contract and return it to LoMastro along with a check for the \$100 membership fee by June 25, if your child is not placed in company we will destroy the check. If you wish for us to charge your payment method on file, please indicate that on the form.

- Dancers who were enrolled during 2020-21, will be placed based on our knowledge of their dance ability and performance skills, non-dance elements will be considered, including: student's attitude, and ability to work with others. Private Auditions will be arranged for new students.
- Dancers will be notified of their general level of acceptance (Petite, Youth, Junior, Senior) by June 28. Because there is substantial progress made during our 3-week Dance Intensive we will wait until after the Dance Intensive performance on July 24 to determine specific casting of smaller groups.
- A private audition may be scheduled if your child was not enrolled at LoMastro for 2020-21. Private lesson fees will apply.

#### 2021-22 Class Requirements / Class Attendance

Class requirements must be maintained for the duration of the 2021-22 school year. Tuition for classes is additional and not included in Company Fees, see the registration form for class tuition information. Dancers must maintain good attendance in all classes and are expected to make-up missed classes. If a student has 3 absences from a class (and fails to make-up the missed classes) he/she will be placed on probation and will not be allowed to perform. Observing class is counted as 1/2 absence. Elective classes can be in any subject. Class requirements may overlap, for example a dancer in both the Sr. Contemporary Division and Sr. Jazz Division would be required to take 2 Ballet classes, not 4. All classes must be taken at LoMastro. Any student with COVID-19 exposure must stay home and participate virtually (will update as the CDC updates their guidance).

#### 2020-21 Rehearsals

Weekly rehearsal days/times are listed on page 1-2. Weekly Rehearsals will be held once per week September 14, 2021 through May 29, 2022.

#### Attendance Policy for Rehearsals / Company Activities

Once families receive the Activity Agenda in August/September, any conflicts must be reported to LPAA immediately, no later than September 1. Students are allowed no more than 5 Company absences throughout the school year (<u>no more than 3 per half year</u>: Aug-Dec, Jan-May). Students are expected to attend all activities and performances. If a student exceeds the allowed number of Company absences he/she will be placed on probation and will not be allowed to perform. Any student with COVID-19 exposure must stay home and participate virtually (will update as the CDC updates their guidance). 12th Graders are allowed 2 additional absences to be used for college visits.

#### Company Fees

Company fees are inclusive of all company expenses including: rehearsals, choreography fees, membership fees, competition fees, The Movement retreat/intensive, adjudications, t-shirts, etc. Fees are paid in installments. If a dancer quits the family is still responsible for fees as listed.

- ▶ The 1st installment is auto-charged on July 1.
- The 2nd Installment is auto-charged on September 15.
- · Costume fees are charged on November 15.
- · Competition fees are charged on January 15.
- The 3rd installment is auto-charged on February 15
- The March 15 charges only apply to those who compete Solo/Duet/Trio and Senior Ballet Divisions which compete at YAGP.
  - ♦ YAGP fees are approximately \$95.00/person, \$60/person per ensemble, \$105.00 per solo.

- New Company members are auto-charged \$88-95 on July 1, for the required company jacket, see below.

#### Company Jackets

Dancers are required to purchase a company jacket. These high-quality jackets are personalized with the dancer's name. The jackets are \$88.00 for youth sizes and \$95.00 for adult sizes. Returning company members do not need to purchase a new jacket, unless they want to. Order deadline July 1.

#### **Costume Policies**

Costumes do not include tights, shoes, etc. If a dancer is injured, dismissed or leaves the company, an understudy may replace him or her. The student leaving the company is expected to turn in all costumes to LPAA; they will be returned to the student after the last performance of the season.

#### The Movement: Retreat / Intensive

We are thrilled to include The Movement as part of our 2021-22 Dance Company experience! All Junior-Senior Dance Company members will receive two full days of mentoring, inspiration, motivation and education. Youth dancers will experience a one day age appropriate version. The Movement goes beyond dance, giving students an escape from their regular classes. This event takes place on-site at LoMastro and teaches the true gifts of self-confidence, vulnerability, acceptance and hard work, in a safe and judgment-free space. Mark your calendars for September 25-26 and save the weekend for The Movement at LoMastro.

#### Photo Shoot

All company dancers will participate in a professional photo shoot on Saturday, September 11. Each dancer will receive 1 Headshots and 2-3 Action shots. Reservations are taken online first-come, first serve.

We'll perform the 25 minute non-stop holiday show at Gorton Center on Dec 5 before heading to Orlando. Jazz dancers ages 8+ are encouraged to apply. #### COVID-19 Pandemic

#### Solo/Duet/Trio Option

Company members 5th grade and older, will have the opportunity to perform duets or trios created by the choreographer of their choice, with the dancers of their choice. Solos can be requested by Senior Co. dancers only. To be eligible, dancers must be enrolled in our 3-week Dance Intensive or Alternative Summer Study (9th-12th gr. Only) Dancers will have the opportunity to perform these dances at Competitions throughout the season. These routines will be taught and rehearsed outside of company rehearsal time. Routines will be taught July-August. If interested, please fill out the enclosed form and return it to the academy prior to June 25. Choreographers have a limited number of routines they will choreograph. Requests will be taken on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Alternative Summer Study (9th-12th Grade Dancers Only): Dancers may elect to attend non-LoMastro intensives and workshops during the summer. Alternative summer study options must include the equivalent number of <u>dance hours</u> as Dance Intensive. Alternative Summer Study may be combined with classes at LoMastro to meet the requirement. Alternative summer study options must be approved by Loren.

#### Solo/Duet/Trio Choreography

Choreography fees cover choreography, 4 hours of lessons to learn the dance and music editing.Solo\$470.00Classical Variation\$470.00Duet\$340.00 per dancerTrio\$290.00 per dancer

#### Competition Fees

Competition fees will be additional. Competition Companies have not committed to fees for 2021-22. Past fees have been as follows: duets/trios approximately \$65 per dancer per competition, Solos approximately \$100-135 per competition.

YAGP Past fees were approximately \$200 for 1 solo which includes master classes (those with 2 solos will pay an additional \$105).

#### Solo/Duet/Trio Rehearsals during the 2021-22 Season / Music & Costume Info

**SELF PRACTICE:** It is expected that the dancers rehearse regularly throughout the year (Sep - May). Dancers are encouraged to rehearse on their own as much as possible and are welcome to use studio space whenever it is available.

**PRIVATE LESSONS:** Students are expected, not required to rehearse with a teacher at least 30 minutes per month Sep-April for each solo/duet/trio. Private lesson fees will apply to these rehearsals (see fees below). Fee listed are per dancer:

Duet / Trio	\$28.00 per 30 minute lesson

**Scheduling Lessons:** Parents may reserve Private Lessons/Rehearsals online, first-come, first-serve online. Duets/Trios must select one parent to be responsible for reserving rehearsal times online.

**Attendance:** Lessons needing to be canceled for any reason (including illness) must be canceled by a parent at least 3 hours prior to the scheduled lesson time to avoid being charged for the lesson.

**Music Selection:** The final selection of appropriate music will be a collaborative effort between dancer(s) and the choreographer. Dancer(s) should include their preferred musical selections on the attached form.

**Costumes:** The selection of appropriate costumes will be the sole decision of the choreographer. If the dancer has a costume they would like to suggest, we welcome their suggestion. Parents will be responsible for costume fees.
